



## Dental Plan Benefits

The Dental plan provides benefits for preventive and diagnostic services (e.g., cleaning, x-ray, and fluoride treatments for children), basic restorative services (e.g., fillings, oral surgery, root canals, and periodontics), major restorative services (e.g., services related to crowns, bridges, and dentures), and orthodontia for both adults and children.

\* Preventive and diagnostic services are not subject to the deductible and will not apply toward the annual maximum benefit limit.

### Usual Reasonable and Customary Charges

Delta Dental out-of-network payments are based on usual reasonable and customary (URC) charges. URC charges are determined by Delta Dental and are based on the range of fees charged by doctors with comparable training and experience for the same or similar service in your area. When you receive in-network care, URC charges do not apply.
